Dear Parents and students

Changes to the school day and timetable for the 2015-16 academic year.

As a school we are continually looking to improve. One area in which we can and need to make some changes is the timetable and school day structure, particularly in the Secondary school. I have convened a timetable committee chaired by Mr. Sealey to research international best practice, the needs of our school, review priorities highlighted in recent DSIB reports and to come forward with proposals. The committee has done a great deal of work, consulted widely, and I hope that the school day structure they have devised is one that will serve the school for many years.

Primary School.

In order to improve standards in the core subjects: literacy and numeracy, students need to spend more time learning these subjects. This means more homeroom time. This should not come at the price of any of the specialist teaching subjects such as languages or PE. We will be lengthening the school day on Tuesday so that it ends at 2.30pm, as with all the other days. Extra-curricular activities will run from 2.30 – 3.30pm Sundays to Wednesdays. The school day will remain the same, starting at 7.45 am. In KG the teaching of Music will be shared between the homeroom teacher and a specialist teacher.

If you have children in both Primary and Secondary we recommend that you choose ECA's on the same day to make lifting easier. The alignment of the ending times of school for Primary and Secondary will remove the need for aftercare.

Secondary School

- The lesson length will increase from 60 to 80 minutes. This was the practice at the school for many years. 4 lessons a day for Grade 6 10 and 5 for Grades 11 and 12.
- The School Day will end at 2:30 for Grades 6 10 (MYP) and 3:30 for Grades 11 and 12 (DP and CP)
- We will be lengthening the school day on Tuesday so that it ends at 2.30pm, as with all the other days.
- There will be a two-week schedule. (A ten-day timetable)
- The length of the breaks will be reduced: 20 minutes for first break and 40 minutes for lunch break.









• Extra-curricular activities will run from 2.30 – 3.30pm Sundays to Wednesdays. No more electives in the timetable – these are now ECA's.
