Footwear requirements

Hair style must be neat and tidy and appropriate styles are at the discretion of the Principal

Jewellery

Students may wear a single small plain stud in each ear. No other jewellery including bracelets, necklaces, anklets and rings are allowed unless requested by the parents and approved by the Principal.

Makeup and Nail Polish

No makeup and no nail polish are allowed.

Swimming

School swimming cap, which can be any colour.

Girls' School swimming costume is standard black one piece available at Sport Stores. Boys' School swimming costume is a standard black trunk available at Sport Stores.

Sports

Students are required to wear their house colour shirts for P.E., which are available at Zaks.
